This year brought several changes to our weekly worship service. We now serve Communion once a month and offer wine in the outer rim of the communion tray. We begin our service with the Praise Team, singing contemporary hymns to prepare the congregation for worship. We asked the choir to meet in the library to keep the narthex clear and hopefully quieter, to allow those in the pews a time for prayer. We purchased ceramic coffee mugs to give to our first time visitors. They are filled with candy, a pencil, and the church brochure. All of the above mentioned changes were positively received. There was always discussion about improving attendance. The diaconate members strived to visit the shut-ins, but there is room for improvement in that area.
