



2014 ANNUAL REPORT

The Women's Fellowship has been very active throughout the year as in past years. We meet the second Wednesday of each month, September-May. The monthly newsletter and Sunday bulletins always keep you informed about our activities. All women of the church are invited to join us at our meeting, which begins at noon. (Exceptions will be noted in the bulletin.) Our meetings begin with devotions. Everyone brings a bag lunch and the hostess furnishes the dessert and beverages. A business meeting follows our lunch.

Listed below are several of the activities we have been involved with during the past year:



We provide food for and serve at funerals. We had 6 funerals & luncheons during the past year that required our services.



We send flowers to all women in the church who were in the hospital and to all our shut-ins throughout the year. We are also taking bread to those who have received flowers previously.



We are continuing to sell our RADA Cutlery as a fundraiser. We have several items still for sale. They can be seen by contacting the office or if you have something specific, it may be ordered through Pam.



We continued the new practice of having our Spring flowers delivered on two different dates. We had the hanging baskets delivered in time for Mother's Day and the flats and urns came two weeks later – just before Memorial Day. We made \$195.59.



The Harvest Supper was held on November 9th. Our count was about the same as the previous year with 68 people in attendance. The women furnished the rolls and the beverages. Don provided a short message and read the things the individuals were thankful for.

The program was held on December 11th. We again enjoyed the "Singing Nuns" from Lake Harbor United Methodist Church. Desserts followed in the candlelit Fellowship Hall. We had 45 women present.



We are continuing to collect Our Family product labels. Just this year we received \$100. It is proving to be a good fundraiser. We have also been receiving Meijer Community Rewards from purchases made by members/friends who have a Meijer Rewards Card. We received \$113.82 from Meijer.



We made Christmas cookies for our shut-ins and brought them to our annual Christmas meeting in December. We put the cookies in covered containers. The cookies were delivered by members of the Women's Fellowship with help from the Diaconate.



We held a Soup Luncheon after the worship service on February 2nd. We did not have a bake sale or cookie walk this year. We made \$328.50.



We had other things that were completed during the year, some by us and other services paid for by the Women's Fellowship.

1. We gave \$200 to the pantry for our mission contribution for the year.
2. From the Soup Luncheon we gave \$328.50 to the church for hand bells.
3. Pat was given \$215 to attend "The Gathering" in Tustin.
4. We purchased 75 soup bowls for the kitchen.
5. We did a luncheon for the Grand West Association Meeting in September.
6. We purchased a 48" flat screen television for \$421.98 for the library.
7. The utensil drawers in the kitchen were cleaned and organized.
8. We held a Flower Power Fundraiser selling flower bulbs and made \$228,
9. The Silent Auction made \$248.75 from the donated baskets.
10. We had a basement sale and made \$533. Thanks to Kim Chappell for all her work on the sale.
